Red Carpet

Last Thursday, we had over 25 women coming to the Red Carpet. It was a very busy day! Needs were met constantly, from serving food to treatments such as pedicures, hair color, haircuts, massage and so on. It is this for which we are aiming. Out of these women, 3 of them are pregnant, including one who is carrying twins. If there will not be a change in the lives of these women, these babies will be given to foster homes or adoption.

The word of Paul in 1 Corinthians 16:9 says: "For a wide door for effective work has opened to me. And there are many adversaries." This describes what is happening to us recently in a greater way. We feel so blessed and honored to be part of this ministry, and to serve these broken women. Yes, indeed, we have an open door to be there and to serve. Some days are quiet and we serve peacefully, yet on other days we are facing violence, fights between the women, shouts and screaming, to the point that one day I had to call the police to intervene.

Ishai

In 2008 a door was opened to Ishai to go to Poland, to the village in which his father used to live before the Second World War. Ishai's father was a holocaust survivor and lost many people from his family. In this process, a contact was made with Polish T.V, and they produced a 52-minute documentary film about Ishai, his family, and our Chaim Beshefa ministry.

When a minister from Poland saw the film, he searched for Ishai for two years. When he finally found him, he invited him to come to Poland to share his testimony. "In the last two years I went to Poland twice. I shared my testimony and my process in reconciliation and forgiveness to the Germans and to the Polish people. For those of you that are interested to see this film, please let us know. We can send it to you via "We Transfer" because it is a big file. The film is in Polish with English subtitles.
